

Agriculture Education & Promotion Development Grant

The purpose of this grant is to aid county Farm Bureaus or Farm Bureau members and educators who do not have adequate funds for a new program or activity, or to assist them in attending an event that enhances the promotion of agriculture and education. Program examples could include, but are not limited to, books for classrooms, incubator systems, supplies for school gardens, etc. Event examples may include the National Ag in the Classroom Conference, AFBF Women's Communication Boot Camp, summer educational programs, specialized educational conferences, etc. There will be two grants awarded during this cycle with the value of \$250 each.

Grant applications are due Oct. 15, 2024.
